## ♂Format♀

Dr. Ritchie will spend time with both parents and their children over six sessions of active learning experiences. Those sessions are outlined below. Adult leaders will accompany the children in mixed gender small groups as they are led by Dr. Ritchie through the curriculum. Parents will be led through a series of workshops, forums, and discussions dealing with raising children in the 5th grade and beyond. Scripture, worship, and music are woven throughout the study. This weekend will be a great experience to worship, learn, play games, eat delicious food, and work on communication building.

**THE PARENT SESSION** gives parents an overview of the study, time to talk together, and an opportunity to ask questions about the study.

**STUDENT SESSION 1** gently eases young persons into the event and overcomes any resistance.

**STUDENT SESSION 2** covers female and male anatomy and growth and development.

**STUDENT SESSION 3** focuses on relationships and God's call to intimacy with God and one another.

**STUDENT SESSION 4** deals with reproduction and all other issues.

**THE PARENT/STUDENT SESSION** The intent of this session is to review new information that was learned during the weekend and to participate in communication exercises.

## Why Them, Why Now?

5th graders are at the ideal age for a study like *Created by God*. While some of them are already familiar with growth spurts, menstruation, deepening voices, and changing family dynamics, such phenomena have not yet taken complete control of their lives. They are curious but not yet obligated to pretend as though they already know everything. When placed in a setting where their ability to understand "adult" information is appreciated and their questions treated with respect, they will ask *anything*.
